# Interest in Accreditation Flourishes in the Pacific Rim

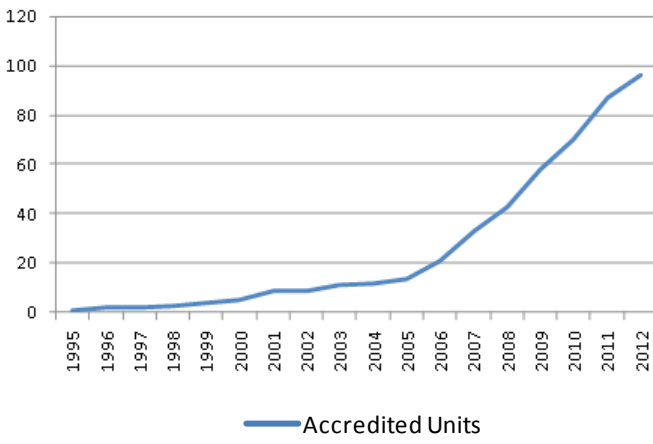


Figure 1. Growth in the number of accredited institutions in the Pacific Rim region.

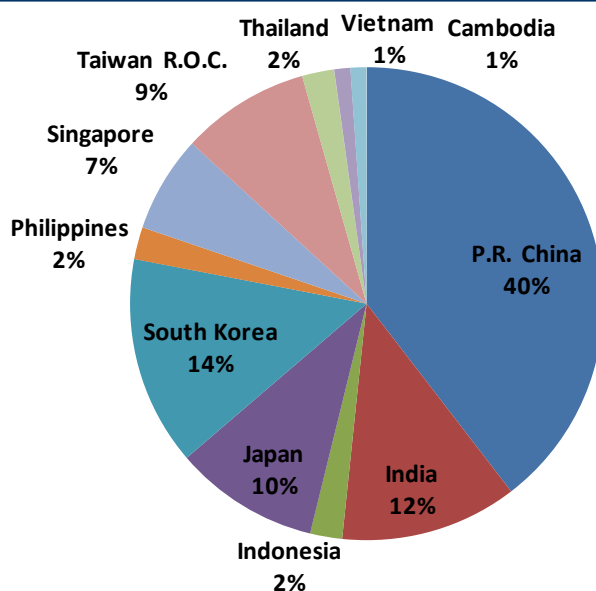


Figure 2. The eleven countries in the Pacific Rim region that have accredited institutions.

Interest in the AAALAC International accreditation program is flourishing in the Pacific Rim region. The number of accredited institutions in the Pacific Rim region continues to grow at a steady pace (Figure 1 below). Two-thirds of all international applications for accreditation originate from institutions located in the Pacific Rim, and these applications represent just under one-third of all new applications. Currently there are 96 AAALAC accredited institutions in eleven Pacific Rim countries including Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Philippines, P.R. China, Singapore, Taiwan R.O.C., Thailand and Vietnam (Figure 2 next page).

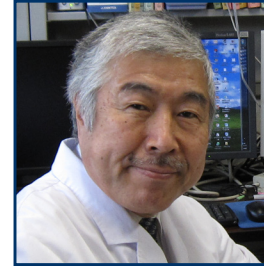
